FROM THE DIRECTOR'S DESK

*I am delighted to submit the Annual Report of **Community Seva Centre** for the year 2010-2011. This annual report carry out our Organisation's development work done for the poor, downtrodden, Abandoned, neglected, backward, ignorant community of tribal development and mainly focusing on overall development of the Child. The actions carried out in this year were having the aim of concentrating mainly on the quality education of the children with good health and secured surrounding. As far as the CCF project concerned we have extended our service to 16 villages and this year CSC concentrated on the development programs for the 1097 who been enrolled and in that 871 children been sponsored and welfare of its families.*

This year's health program was concentrated mainly on awareness about general health care, T.B, Malaria, Family Planning & HIV/AIDS diseases. The HIV/AIDS patients provided with nutritious food everyday through project. Along with that, the immunization & nutritional status of <5yrs old children was confirmed 100%.

Women were made aware about ORT/ARI, reproductive health and importance of safe drinking water for the family.

Under nutrition program the enrolled families benefited by the trainings and awareness on balanced diet, PD Hearth, low cost nutritious food preparation. The needed families were provided with free vegetable seeds with training on how to maintain kitchen garden.

In the Early Child Care Development (ECCD), mother's meets were conducted every month and childcare practice awareness was given in pre schools. For pre-school workers 10 days residential training were provided in the child care for effective growth of children and cooking equipments for mid day nutritious meals. Extra curricular activities were encouraged through free summer camp for rural poor children, celebration of annual day and exposure trip.

To encourage women empowerment and economic growth that the community Seva centre formulated 281 SHG in Puducherry, 50 SHG in Kalvarayan Hills. Regular trainings on capacity building, leadership quality, income generating activities, importance of SHG records maintenance given through various programs & exposure trip. The livelihood activities extended to 258 more CCF families through LEEP grand / loan and activity training. The federation expanded its activities to Kalyarayan hills tribal people of Villipuram district Tamil Nadu state. Compared to last year's statistics, overall health, education and economic status of the people was improved and it's useful to 3000-4000 more beneficiaries of the project area.

Each and every pages of this report has our gratitude for the assistance and service rendered by funding agencies, which have contributed much valuable support to the Community Seva center. I take this opportunity to release this Annual Report as a meager achievement towards the welfare of large miseries of our community. And expect the same kind of help and co-operation from the people and organizations who helped us directly and indirectly to continue our service.

Introduction:

Community Seva Centre is a social service organization serving for the poorest of the poor in the villages of Ariyankuppam Commune in Pondicherry UT and

Kalvarayan hills in TamilNadu since 1993, covering nearly 64 surrounding villages. We are working for child development from womb to teenage, the immunization, nutrition, breast feeding, pre-natal and post-natal care are given for mother and child. CSC is running pre-schools for the development of children below 5 yrs of age, 13 pre-schools in Pondy and 5 in Kalvarayan hills. School going children are supported with supplementary education in night study centre, and summer camps, extra curricular activities, exposure trips, counseling, career guidance, vocational training, sports materials etc has been provided to teenagers to shape their future as they deserve. Women are given awareness on health care, kitchen gardening, and economically empowered through self-help groups. Nearly 320 SHG's are running under community centre in all the 3 regions and women are linked to banks and markets. Community Seva Centre serving the community by serving the people who are in need, who need helping hand to rise and awake for the better tomorrow. The action plan, the hurdles faced, the achievements, the future plan is being reviewed in this annual report. The end of the year will give new hopes and new responsibilities. But at the same time, past experience are very important for any organization, it should be treasured and measured for the better achievements for future.

BACKGROUND OF THE ORGANISATION:

Community Seva Centre is a non-governmental organization registered under Indian society act of 1860 and started serving the society from then. It is purely service oriented NGO, not influenced by any political party or communal organization, believes in equality. Community Seva Centre is mainly affiliated to CCF International USA for the development of children, family and Community. It also has joint programs with State and Central government, The Bryan Guinness charitable trust UK, CINI –India , GOAL-Ireland, MJS –France, University, Medical colleges of Pondicherry, and working voluntarily in Kalvarayan hills for the tribal people development.

GEOGRAPHICAL AREA OF WORKING:

Community Seva Centre is working in 16 villages for the overall development of the community people who are living in 16 villages.

MAJOR ESTABLISHMENTS: The community Seva Centre is established various program in placed at Puducherry and Kallvarayan Hills of Vilupuram district of Tamil Nadu. The organization is implemented around 18 pre-school centres for under 5 year children, promoted around 281 women & Men SHGs trained them for MFI program among SHG members, developed Village knowledge Centre where the community can access all kind of information towards development, established the vocational Training centre like Tailoring Centre and Computer Education Centre towards create better environment for employment among youths, Continue the support for around 888 children through sponsorship program in Pondicherry Union territory. Running of Primary School, Residential home for senior citizen home, Home for orphanage children in the tribal area of Kalvarayan hills,

The Community Seva Centre is progressing with the following objectives:-

OBJECTIVES:

- To promote and arrange sponsor for children to render help for education Of Children and there by promote the welfare of the families.
- To help the economically, socially and communally weaker Sections.

- To start and commence all Socio Economic and advance programmer courses also non-formal and adult education and awareness program.
- To take over, merger, amalgamate, aide, control, manage, administrate the Institutions or units organization those who are having similar objects.
- To render help to free training centres for tailoring embroidering housekeeping, knitting, family planning, small savings Literacy, Social education Child care, Sanitation, Computer IGP etc., for girls and restitutes.
- To set up small scale units under self-employment scheme to educated youths and girls.
- To affiliate and maintain close liaison with the other similar social service organizations both in and out of India and to act as an agency to the supporting organization.
- To engage in social service activities aimed at to promote the living condition and general welfare of the poor without discrimination of race, community, cares, of creed.
- To create housing project through helping institutions.
- To develop agriculture and environmental growth wasteland development and run co-operative agriculture society.
- To conduct research and training in folk arts and ancient medicines
- To encourage and form self Help Groups among women and Men.
- To work for the welfare and upliftment of the poor Tribals and their children in Kalvarayan Hills.

HEALTH AND SANITAINON

Good health and Good Sanitation practices are very essential for the well-being of the Society. Relatively the modest investment on Primary Health care, Water and Sanitation can make enormous strides in reducing poverty and improve the quality of life. The impact of these initiatives will be sustainable through SHGs. These efforts will

contribute to the eradication of Polio, Communicable Diseases and helps to prevent other prevalent diseases like HIV/AIDS. In order to fulfill the above mentioned objectives we have organized regular Weekly meetings with the Peer Groups, conducted 2 Health Camps for Adolescents, 2 Camps in RTI/STI, Conducted exhibitions in 2 High Schools, organized IEC cultural programs, supplied emergency Medicines, gave referral support for test and ARV treatment, Conducted Situation Assessment on HIV/AIDS, conducted children rally on child Rights and Protection Week. We have also conducted various awareness programs, through these programs; we have reduced the percentage of MMR, and IMR in our targeted Villages. The eligible couples adopting Family Planning has increased. Immunization for the (12-23) month old Children have been done in 93% of the total cases in our area of operation. Knowledge levels on ORT / ARI have increased. Schoolchildren got educated about HIV/AIDS. There is a reduction in communicable diseases in our coverage area because of various awareness campaigns Conducted by us.

We have mainly focused our attention in the field of Health and Sanitation through the following activities:

- Improving RCH through IEC, BCC treatment and services preventive aspect of HIV/AIDS through IEC/BCC referral services.
- Special focus of Adolescents, youth and children working in Hotel, Resorts, agricultural farmhouses, fishing and in other industries.
- Supportive services for TB Patients.
- Total Village Environmental sanitation and family based of individual toilets construction.
- School health Program
- Preventive health care programs in partnership with SHGs
- Access to safe drinking water

IEC PROGRAM ON RCH

Information, Education and Communication program was organized for the different target groups Mothers, SHG Members, Pregnant Mothers and other family member's subject covering Immunization, Family Planning, Nutrition and Self Hygiene. In this program more than 1630 participants were participated and gained knowledge on the different period of immunization for the children and pregnant mothers, importance of Nutrition and different kinds of low cost nutritious food, maintenance of personal hygiene and about the temporary and permanent method of family planning. 80% of the children and pregnant mothers are fully immunized, 80% of the people are maintaining the personal hygiene, 60% of the peoples are adopting temporary method of family planning, 40% of the people are following the preparation of low cost nutritious food, 60% of the childrens were moved from 3rd grade to 2nd grade. IMR and MMR rate were reduced for 100%

LIFE SKILL EDUCATION FOR ADOLESCENT GIRLS ON RCH

Life skill educations on RCH for adolescents were organized for the target villages. Around 386 adolescent girls were participated in this program and gained their knowledge on about personal hygiene, problems of RCH. Through this program 75% of the girls were improved in their Individual development, decision making and in social development, communication skill, Personality development, leadership quality, personal health & hygiene.

RTI/STI CAMP

RTI/STI camp was organized in the 2 cluster level. More than 250 mothers and adolescent girls were participated and gained knowledge on symptoms and causes RTI/STI problems, maintaining of personal hygiene, using of sanitary napkin. Through this camp we identified 18 RTI/STI cases and referral services were made. The iron and folic tablets were provided to the anemic patients. 25% of the adolescent girls were

identified that they are having regular white discharge and referred them to the Local PHC's and GH.

HEALTH CAMP FOR ADOLESCENTS

2 Health Camp for Adolescent girls were organized in the project area. More than 200 Girls were participated and clarified their doubt With the doctor. Through medical check we Identified 25% of the girls are having regular White discharge and 30% of the girls were identified that they are having abdominal pain during the menstruation and they were referred to the Local PHC's and GH. And iron and folic Tablets were provided to the anemic patients.

REGULAR WEEKLY MEETING AMONG PEER GROUPS

Regular weekly meeting for peer groups(adolescent girls, family members and SHG's) were provided to strength the peer groups physically as well as mentally.4 representatives from each peer groups were participated and gained and updated their knowledge on Reproductive and Child Health, personal hygiene and other health issues in regular meeting. This program helps them to share their problems which they cannot share with their parents. Through these they are implementing the same with the peer groups and identified 2 RCH patients and referred them to the GH by the peer educators.

CAPACITY BUILDING FOR PROJECT FIELD STAFF

2 programs on Capacity building for project Field staffs were provided. In this training 100 Field staffs were participated and trained in RCH knowledge, Personal hygiene,

Using of sanitary napkins, pre and post

Natal care and developed their communication

Skills to implement the same in the field level. 80% of the field staffs are adopting the same in the field.

TRAINING OF HEALTH WORKERS ON RCH & COMMUNICATION SKILLS

2 Trainings were provided to 60 Health workers from Sub centres and Anganwadi teachers and gained knowledge on RCH (symptoms and Causes) and developed their communication skills. Through this training participants were trained how to organize meeting with mothers and caregivers on Personal hygiene, overall development of the children, Immunization, Environmental hygiene, home based care to the children, immediate first aid in case of child infection etc. Capacity building and communication skills training also provided to the participants to implement the same in the field level. 80% of the health workers are following the same in the field.

HIV / AIDS PROGRAMS

HIV / AIDS is a major public health problem claiming the lives of 20 million people, with over 37 million people world wide now living with this disease. Social, cultural, Economic and legal factors execrate the spread of HIV and heighten the impact of HIV / AIDS. Children are the most affected by HIV and they are often the most over looked with regard to the interventions aimed at preventing HIV / and mitigating its impact. As per the CCF, directions Community Seva Centre concentrate on the children regarding the prevention methodology of AIDS.

IEC PROGRAM

8 IEC program on Care and support

on HIV/AIDS, were provided to the various community level stake holders. In this program more than 300 members were participated and gained knowledge on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS, and the referral services for the diseased person.

70% of the community people maintaining personal as well as environmental hygiene to reduce the malaria infection.

BASIC FACTS FOR HIV/AIDS AND LIFE SKILL FOR YOUTH

Life skill educations on HIV/AIDS were provided to youth in our target village. In this program more than 300 youths were participated and Dr. Thamizhvanan from Local PHC were participated and gave his advocacy on HIV/AIDS, about the causes, prevention and referral services for HIV/AIDs. Through this program 60% of the youth is developed their capacity in decision making, problem solving and developed their individual development. Through script and songs youths were expressed their opinions regarding HIV/AIDS.

TRAINING FOR HEALTH WORKERS ON MALARIA

2 Training for Health workers, fields staffs and Anganwadi workers on Malaria were provided to 130 workers and they trained and gained their knowledge on causes and prevention of Malaria and the way to give the first aid for the affected children. 80% of the health workers implementing the same in the field and 50% malaria disease is reduced in community.

EXHIBITION, SENSITIZATIONS ON STIGMA REDUCTION

2 Exhibitions were conducted in High and Higher secondary schools on HIV/AIDS. More than 550 students were participated in this exhibition and gained their knowledge in causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS through wall posters, film show, and advocacy and through IEC materials and they question their doubts related to HIV.█

WORLD AIDS DAY

World Aids day program were celebrated in project area. More than 320 members were participated in this program and gained knowledge on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS and the referral services. Through script, awareness songs and advocacy the opinions about the HIV/AIDS, Causes and prevention method.

TRAINING OF PEER EDUCATORS AND CHILDREN AS PEER EDUCATORS

Training on HIV/AIDS peer educators were provided to the 150 children (10 representatives from the children club). Through them more than 650 community peer educators were gained knowledge on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS and referral services for HIV/AIDS and sharing their knowledge to their peer groups.

PPTC/ICTC

PPTC/ICTC training was provided to the SHG members. They developed in Communication level about the PPTC/ICTC to implement in the project level. Through this program 18 pregnant mothers were tested for the HIV/AIDS and oral tablets were provided to them and they gained knowledge on Causes and Prevention of the disease.

CONDOM PROMOTION-PROCUREMENT, DISTRIBUTION AND DEMONSTRATION

Condom promotion and procurement were provided in 4 target villages for the youth and parents. More than 285 participants were participated and gained knowledge on condom promotion. Demonstration was provided by the staff from Pondicherry Aids Control Society and condom was distributed in all project area. And 40% of the people are following temporary method of family planning.

NUTRITION

It is a astonishing fact that one in every three malnourished children in the world, lives in India. More than half of the children in India under the age of five years are either moderately or seriously malnourished. In our area of operation, the mal nourishment is attributed to the social and economical backwardness of the Villagers. Poor hygiene, inadequate sources of income to the families and the absence of good child Health practices also contribute much to the mal Nourishment of the children.

In order to over come this and make the children well nourished in our targeted areas, we have demonstrated in 16 villages about the Low cost Nutritious food, and helped 75 families for the establishment of Kitchen Garden, conducted 2 PD Hearth sessions, conducted mothers meeting regarding Growth monitoring & Sensitization on Deworming, started ICDS centres, Supplied Supplementary Nutritious food , gave training to all service providers, gave refresher training on PD Hearth, and also IEC and BCC Materials for nutrition developed.

TRAINING OF ALL SERVICE PROVIDERS IN NUTRITIONAL COUNSELING

2 trainings were provided to all service providers to develop their communication skill in the nutrition counseling. More than 60 participants from Anganwadi, SHG members, mothers and caregivers were participated and developed their communication skill in nutrition counseling and implementing the same in the field.

WORKSHOP ON NUTRITIONAL STATUS

Two days workshops on Nutritional status were organized to the Service providers. More than 120 service providers were participated and share their Childs nutritional status. In this program we identified after providing a nutrition program 50% of childrens were moved from IInd grade to Ist Grade.

QUALITY NUTRITION

Quality nutritional program were organized for the mothers and caregivers in the CCF target villages networking and collaboration with the ICDS. In this program more than 80 mothers and caregivers were participated and gained knowledge on preparation of low cost nutritious food and how to prepare a hygienic food and about the nutritious grains, vegetables and fruits and IEC material on Nutrition is also provided to the participants

PD HEARTH

2 PD hearth program in two different villages for 15 days and one review and orientation program were organized. 80 participants were participated and gained knowledge on personal hygiene, environmental hygiene, preparation of low cost nutritious food, to develop their child physically and mentally etc. Local ANM and PHC's doctors were gave suggestions to develop the better health of their children.

SUPPLEMENTARY NUTRITION

Community Seva Centre is running 13 pre-school centres in the target villages with the aid of central and state social welfare board. In this program more than 450 children are getting regular supplementary food with snacks. More than 210 childrens were moved from 1st grade to Normal grade.█

MOTHERS AND COMMUNITY MEETING ON GROWTH MONITORING

In mothers community meeting more than 250 mothers and caregivers were participated and gained knowledge on Growth monitoring chart and deworming. Through this program they learn how to monitor their Childs growth monitoring chart and regularly they are attending the parents meeting and upgrading their Childs status in their growth.

EARLY CHILD CARE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

In order to give early care and development to the children under the age of 5 years, Community Seva Centre is running 13 pre schools at various villages in Ariankuppam and in Nettapakkam Commune Panchayat in Pondicherry. Under this program, nearly 316 children were taken care of. The children below 5 years were enrolled under this program. Community Seva Centre passed a resolution for the teachers' adequate meeting and training for the professionally implemented developmental programs. Apart from this, awareness programs for the parents of the children were conducted along with various innovative new programs. In order to implement the program more effectively and fruitfully Management committee has been formed.

Objectives:

- *To develop awareness on the childcare for the mothers.*
- *Training for the Pre-School teachers to use the technical aids.*
- *To provide awareness and prevention of health hazard for the children and pregnant women.*
- *To improve the thinking level and the IQ of the Pre-School children through play way method.*

TOT TRAINING FOR CRECHE WORKERS/CARETAKERS

This training was providing for the Pondicherry state Creche workers and caretakers with the link of State social Welfare Board and ICDS Department.

This program has been planned for 15 batches and 30 participants in each batch. Now 7 batches has been completed and other in process. In this training with the help of ICDS department we are providing the knowledge about the children like Overall development of the children, Personal Hygiene, Environmental Hygiene, Low cost nutritious food, To prepare a teaching and learning material with the help of wastages, How to teach the Action songs and Action story, Immunization and growth monitoring chart, Roles and responsibilities of CWBC and ECCD Management committee and the participants are gained knowledge and implementing the same in the field.

ECCD MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

ECCD management committee was organized every month in the pre-school centre. We are having 13 management committee each committee have 7 members from SHG, Youth club, Adolescent club, pre-school Parents, village panchayat and pre-school Teacher. Through this committee the needs of the pre-school centre will be satisfied through local mobilization of the committee members. Through ECCD management committee members one pre-school centre was white washed and play and teaching material were provided to the e pre-school centre.█

REGULAR GROUP SESSION WITH MOTHERS AND CARE GIVERS

This is a monthly program. Every month more than 20 parents will attend the meeting and updated their knowledge on their child's nutritional status through growth monitoring chart. In every meeting teacher explained about the different topic and parents will gain knowledge on the developmental topic like Overall development of the child, personal hygiene, Immunization, environmental hygiene, how to prepare the low cost nutritious food etc., and the parents implementing the same at the home.

TRAINING AND EXPOSURE FOR ECCD CARETAKERS AND WORKERS

2 days training and 2 days exposure were organized for the ECCD caretakers and workers.

In this training 30 Anganwadi workers including welfare officers were participated and gained their knowledge in developing the child in Personal hygiene, environmental hygiene, overall development etc and implementing the same in the field.

TRAINING FOR ECCD MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

2 days training were provided to the ECCD Management committee members regarding the development of the ECCD centre. In this training 30 representatives (2 members

from each committee) from all committee members were participated and gained knowledge on their roles and responsibilities in developing the pre-school centers

BASIC EDUCATION

Basic education is fundamental to the healthy growth of the children with full potential. Community Seva Centre gives specific focus on the female children's education from the early childhood. We have also conducted various School based Quality improvement programs in our coverage area in this regard.

SQUIP:

School based quality improvement plan and implementation were organized for the 4 school in the project area (karikalampakkam, Nonankuppam). Through identification and assessment for 12 months plan the project has been identified and provided the lacking materials to the schools like Library Books, Science Equipments, Reconstruction of Toilets, providing sports materials, Dictionary to every students.

GLOBAL ACTION WEEK

Global Action week were celebrated in the project area. More than 200 children's, 100 SHG members, 100 youth were participated in this program and competitions, sports and cultural programs were organized for the participants.

SPECIAL TUITION

In order to educate and to prepare the X standard students to appear for the Public exams Special Tuitions were conducted by the Community Seva Centre. Around 150 students both boys & girls were enrolled and benefited for special coaching class who will be attending in State board examination .The students for this coaching class were selected from our targeted villages by the help of the Animators. This program was implementing in the 5 schools in the target villages. This program is in process.

Livelihood and Economic Enhancement Programme

MILCH ANIMAL AND VACCINATION MEDICINE

40 Milch Animal were provided to 20 Families. And they are benefiting through Selling the milk in the milk centre and by Using the own and vaccination and Medicine were provided to the sick milch Animal through monthly regular check up.

TAILORING TRAINING CENTRE

Under the Employable skill program, we are providing tailoring training to 30 Adolescents. They were taught Embroidery, blouse stitching and also about the preparation of various decorative items for the House. During the evening, they were taught about Wire Spinning. Through this the Adolescents learn to make Wire Hand Bags and many Handicraft items using the different color Wires.

COMPUTER COURSE

Under Employable Skill Training for the 17 adolescent girls in target villages were provided a 4 month Advance Diploma in Computer Application for free of cost and With certificate. Through this course they are well versed in Ms Office, Ms Excel, Ms PowerPoint , Adobe PageMaker, Adobe Photoshop and Internet Concept.

BEAUTICIAN COURSE

Under Employable Skill Training Beautician Course for 4 months with certificate were provided to 19 girls in our target villages. This program helps them for their individual

development as well as economic development. Through this training they are well versed in Fruit Facial, Herbal Facial, 3 types of Bleaching, Medicare, Pedicure, Hair Straightening, Threading, Yoga and Meditation etc.,

DRIVING

Under Employable Skill Training the Driving course is provided for 4 months for 30 youths in our target village with of free of cost and certificates are provided by the Youth co-coordinator of Nehru Yuva Kendra. Through this training 30 youths were benefited for the self employment.

EMERGENCY

FLOOD

Community Seva Centre will be the First person to assist the Victims of any natural calamities in its coverage area. Our Animators will inform about any death or any natural calamities occurred in our area with in few minutes of such occurrence. Immediately the Emergency Section of our office will take suitable action for the rehabilitation of such victims. We also provide the victims the basic need such as vassals, Provisions, Mats, Bed Sheets, Plastic Buckets, Kerosene Stows, Sarris, Dhotis and other items required for their urgent needs This year in November month there was a heavy flood in our 5 target villages. We provide relief materials for more than 200 families. Immediately CSC provide the Food and water as a first relief to the flood victims. And also victims were arranged for their staying in the local panchayat building and in marriage Hall by getting the permission to the prior authority. With the help of the Generator the flood water was disposed from the victims' home.█

CHILD PARTICIPATION AND CHILD PROTECTION

CAPACITY BUILDING FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH CLUB

Capacity building for Children club and Youth club were organized in the project level. Around 630 children and youth were participated and gained knowledge on Childs right and protection. The debate were conducted in the topic In the development of Child and youth whether family support, Society support and Media support were conducted and children and youth were argued their opinion.

CHILDS RIGHT WEEK

Childs right week celebration was celebrated in the project level area. More Than 300 children, 30 members from CWBC, 100 parents and 100 youth were participated and gained knowledge on Basic child right, legal rights and child protection. Rally was conducted and handbills related to the Child's right and protections were issued to the public. Advocacy on Childs right and protection was provided to the children by the Legal Advisor Mrs. Usha. Cultural Programs was did by Children. Through this program 2 child marriages and 3 child labors were restricted by the Child Club and Youth club.

TRAINING TO ANGANWADI TEACHERS ON CHILD PROTECTION

This program was organized to the Anganwadi teachers on Childs right and protection. Around 60 anganwadi teachers including welfare officers were participated and gained knowledge on Child rights and protection and implementing the same in the field.

TOT FOR CRECHE WORKERS AND FIELD STAFFS

One day TOT training provided to the Crèche workers and field staffs related to the Child rights and protection. In this training Around 30 participants were participated and Gained knowledge on Childs right and protection and implementing the same in the Field level.

CAMPAIGN WITH CHILDREN AND YOUTH

Campaign with children and youth were organized and around 420 child and youth were participated and gained knowledge on children rights and protection. And some of the children and youth shared their problems they are facing in the family as well as society

CAPACITY BUILDING ON CHILD AGENCY

Training on Child rights and protection were provided to the PRI/SHG and various Child Agency in the project level area. In these training around 65 members from various Child Agency and SHG members were participated and gained knowledge on child Rights and protection and implementing the Same in the field level.
